## TWIN LAKES EVACUATION PLAN

- Mandatory emergency evacuation of the Twin Lakes homesites will be made by the Code Red - 911 Reverse call emergency notification system or by direct warning.
  - Contact neighbors to insure they are aware of evacuation notice.
- Residents are requested to leave immediately once the evacuation notice has been issued. DO NOT DELAY!
- Evacuation aid will be available for elderly or special needs residents requiring functional assistance evacuating.
  - To receive this aid residents must arrange in advance with the Sheriff's department.
- Twin Lakes Road is the ONLY evacuation route out of the Twin Lakes drainage. Emergency personnel will respond to facilitate an orderly evacuation.
  - Lower Twin Lakes Road-South Side may be used as an evacuation route.
  - Emergency personnel may not be available to assist on this road.
- Continue along Twin Lakes Rd evacuation route to Bridgeport.
- Do not stop along the roadside to view fire fighting activity.
- An emergency information assembly center will be established at "Busters" parking lot located at the North end of Bridgeport near the intersection of Hwy 395 and Twin Lakes Rd.
- Twin Lakes FSC and TLPOA members will be available to communicate information received from a Fire Information Officer.
- Reentry into evacuated areas will be prevented until emergency personnel are certain conditions are safe.
